Internal Auditor's/Audit Board Report

- I have examined the books of account and records from which the final accounts were prepared and have obtained all the information and explanations that were necessary for the purpose of my internal audit.
- 2. I certify that end of period checks have been conducted in accordance with Service Funds Regulations.
- 3. Subject to the observations given below I am satisfied that proper books of account have been kept and that the final accounts give a true and fair view of the results of transactions over the period and of the state of the Fund's affairs as at the date of the balance sheet. Subject also to my observations I am satisfied that cash and bank balances and stocks on hand have been properly checked at prescribed intervals and that adequate insurance exists.
- 4. I have stamped and the original books of account and the original records I have checked. All vouchers relating to this account have been cancelled.
- I have made the following observations whilst carrying out the internal audit:
 - a. General. Previous observations have been actioned. The statement of financial activities reflects the total incoming resources are above £100k and the fund is registered with the Charity Commission (registered number: 261420). The previous period total matches the total funds brought forward. The bank account balance is greater than the amount held in restricted funds. There is no GPF Income over Expenditure this year. The FM will recommence the use of GPF as appropriate and GPF will be adjusted accordingly. Balance on account last year was £2,000,560.39 and this year it is £2,309,871.13.
 - b. Restricted Funds. The 2 restricted funds have seen movement throughout the accounting period and have been controlled in accordance with the fund's constitution and charter. Both are necessary however, funds from R001 (Britannia House Operating) must transfer funds to the GPF in order for the issue at para 5a to be rectified.
 - Property. A property check was conducted as part of the end of year audit for the Brit House and no property
 adjustments or depreciation is necessary.
 - d. Debtors. Debtors are £3,631.02 which is 0.15% of the current assets. Debts have been assessed as being reasonable (wages and floats) and recent.
