- .1) The provision of football and boxing sessions to boys and girls ranging from 5 to 16 years of age. There are 8 sessions per week across both sports. All essential equipment is provided by the club. We have an open access policy for both sports.
- 2) Assistance provided to our youngsters to progress within their chosen sport. In football this includes arranging for club trials and organising league competitions. In boxing this includes arranging for youngsters to become registered as competitive boxers with the NGB (should they so wish) and accompanying them to tournaments
- 3) An assessment and award system to help the progressive development of the young athletes. These awards are not only given for physical skills, but also for mental attitude and behaviour.
- 4) The provision of recreational and competitive boxing to adults. The sessions are open access, and attendees are assisted with their training according to their ability and aspiration within the sport.
- 5) The provision of coaching to adults wishing to compete. Arranging for their registration with the NGB. Accompanying the boxers to tournaments.
- 6) Outreach work in schools to teach boxing.
- 7) In house boxing for youth groups.

- 4) Afewee U11'S player Samuel signs for Arsenal Football Club at the Arsenal headquarters in Hale End (March 2019)
- 5) Afewee U8's player Rayan signed for Arsenal Academy at their London Colney training centre
- 6) Afewee U12's player Ilyas signed for Layton Orient FC (April 2019)
- 7) Afewee founder Steadman Scott receives an award from Duke of Kent at the Amplifon Awards for Brave Britons. Some of the most courageous and dedicated people in the UK received their prizes from his Royal Highness, the Duke of Kent, at the Amplifon Awards for Brave Britons 2019. The awards took place at the Army and Navy Club in Pall Mall, where Falklands War hero Simon Weston hosted the event on behalf of global hearing giants Amplifon. From more than 300 nominations there were four finalists in the six categories – Steadman being nominated in the 'Charity Champion' category for his services to his community over the past 20 + years.





