In 2018, the new political party came into power. It has implemented new rules and routine on charities. Therefore, we are still struggling to get register SAMEO in Pakistan. I have visited Pakistan twice this year, did philanthropic work re charity clinics to provide free consultation and treatment to marginalised community to improve their RMNCH care.</p> <p>I have also visited various charity organisations in Iraq such as in Bagdad, Najaf and Karbala to assess RMNCH care in general. Now I'm supporting Al Asre foundation to build maternity hospital in Najaf to serve marginalised community. I will be working as a chief medical advisor there.</p> <p>I have participated Women Deliver Conference Vancouver, Canada in June 2019 and ESHRE scientific meeting In Vienna in June 2019 to assess the global progress in RMNCH care as per Global Health Strategy 2016-2030.</p>
