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Report of the Trustees for the year ended 5 April 2019

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5 April 2019. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The objects of the trust are of a general charitable nature.

The trustees have discretion to apply the capital and income of the trust fund by making payments to such charities or for charitable purposes in such manner as they shall decide.

Grantmaking

In default of appointment the trustees hold the capital and income for the following named charities:

Each year the trustees approve grants to the above charities and in furtherance of the general charitable objects may make grants to other institutions involved in the education and development of young people and smaller grants on application by individuals to help with the costs of their education in the performing arts.

Investment performance and financial review

The trustees' investment objectives are to generate sufficient income to assist the various charities to which it is committed.

The income return based on the value of the investments, which increased by £738 during the year to 5 April 2019. At 5 April 2019 the general reserves were £581,528, a decrease of £18,119 below the figure shown at the previous year end.

Notes to the Financial Statements for the year ended 5 April 2019

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention with the exception of investments which are included at market value, as modified by the revaluation of certain assets.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

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Investment income

Investment income relates to listed investment. The movement in market value is reflected in the Statement of Financial Activities.
