The agreement with UCP will provide the Society with a royalty revenue stream with which we will cover operating expenses and fund further activities in the future in line with our charitable goals. In addition to establishing the Society as a registered charity, this year we have undertaken foundational work to put in place a range of policies and facilities for the good governance of the organisation. Key policies formally adopted by the Trustees and Executive Committee include a Code of Conduct and Financial Management Policy. We are also working on updating and expanding on the current Privacy Policy.
