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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2018

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2018. ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

HPPC continues to go through a transition period and we were delighted to move to our new premises in Watford. This venue allowed us the space and time to cater to the needs of te community. We offered counselling, training classes and were able to hold regular all Night Prayer Services for the first time.

We were grateful to be able to receive 50 used chairs which were obtained free of charge through the information of one of the church members. We held regular outreach days where the members engaged the community in conversation sharing what we do as a church.

Our telephone outreach dubbed 'Destiny Moment' which is a 5 minute audio message from the Pastors, encouraged many and we received daily replies from all over the world requesting prayer as well as sharing their stories.

We offered benevolence through our welfare department to a number of members as well as support to members going through health issues.

Our goals for the coming year are to expand our services in the local community by holding regular youth services and introducing instrument lessons.

We also aim to try and work with local charities and hold training and motivational forums to continue to support and train people to become more independent.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2018

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
