REVIEW OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE FRAMLINGHAM CHRISTIAN SCIENCE SOCIETY, Y/E 31st SEPTEMBER 2019

As an independent examiner with no membership or financial connections to the Christian Science Society of Framlingham I have reviewed their accounts for the 2019 financial year and have found them to be in good order.

My methodology consisted of taking samples of the accounting records produced by the treasurer for randomly selected months and comparing this to the bank account statements and petty cash vouchers. I also looked at a selection of amounts paid and received to ensure that, in my subjective judgement, they did not appear to be unusual or unreasonable.

In the few occasions where I found discrepancies I could not immediately explain, the treasurer was able to resolve my queries satisfactorily. A small discrepancy in the Barclays statement for the end of the financial year was attributed to uncleared items which she itemized for me, and a variance in the petty cash was explained by a voucher which I had overlooked.

I do not have any professional accounting credentials, but as a reasonable and unbiased observer I was satisfied that the records I examined were accurate and correct.
