Selsey Community Forum has continued in 2019 to encourage partnership working so residents can discern and meet their own needs.

Led by a trustee committee of 8 the charity has operated its fundraising policy faithfully and ensured all safeguarding and staff needs have been met. Adequate insurance and fiscal probity have been ensured. Trustees Fred Allen, Brian Hall, Simon Keen, John Fletcher, Karen Pirks, Colin Rickman and Mike Nicholls have ensured compliance with charity governance.

Six forums have met on a total of 47 occasions to plan work for young people, adult social care, seeking funding, sharing organisational information, encouraging leadership and exercising oversight.

Selsey Care Shop,has seen 6000 calls made and 3000 visitors enquire for information. Newcomers, tourists, outside agencies and older people have been served. The service now copes with dementia, Carers, Wellbeing and activity support. 21 different events are run each month.

Organised a Christmas Day lunch

Administered a £20000 grant fund on behalf of Ferry Farm Community Solar.

Encouraged SCF Workshops.

Formed SCF Catering

Oversee Selsey Dementia Action Alliance and Carers Support Selsey.
