- CONTINUED TO PROVIDE THE ISLAMIC EDUCATION CLASSES FOR 150 CHILDREN INCLUDING THE QURAN RECITATION CLASSES
- PROVIDED GIFTS TO ELDERLY AND VULNERABLE PERSONS IN CARE HOMES IN BLACKBURN

ABORAD, THE CHARITY:

- DELIVERED FOOD AND ESSENTIALS PACKS TO OVER 1.000 SYRIAN REFUGEES IN JORDAN
- PROVIDED FOOD TO POOR PEOPLE IN SIERRA LEONE, GAZA AND LEBANON
- PROVIDED 20 WATER PUMPS IN WEST BENGAL IN INDIA
- REFURBISHED MOSQUE IN WEST BENGAL TO HAVE IMPROVED FACILITIES AND CLEAN TOILETS
- PROVIDED FOOD AND CLOTHING TO ORPHANAGE IN SIERRA LEONE

THE ABOVE ACTIVITIES HAVE ALLOWED THE CHARITY TO ALLEVIATE FINANCIAL HARDSHIP FOR THOSE IN NEED AND TO ADVANCE ISLAM FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT. THE TRUSTEES HAVE HAD DUE REGARD TO THE PUBLIC BENEFIT GUIDANCE OF THE CHARITY COMMISSION AND CONFIRM THAT THEY ARE DELIVERING PUBLIC BENEFIT.

DURING THE PERIOD, THE CHARTY SECURED INCOME FROM THE PUBLIC OF £69,560 AND EXPENDED £67,072, THE MAIN EXPENDITURE BEING GRANTS, STAFF AND PREMISES COSTS. DURING THE YEAR A SURPLUS OF £2,488 WAS GENERATED WHICH ADDED TO THE RESERVES, MAKNG THE RESERVES £19,195. THE CHARITY'S POLICY IS TO RETAIN RESERVES OF 3 MONTHS OF OPERATIONAL COSTS OF £9,000 AND THE REMAINDER TO BE SPENT ON FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE .
