Circuit Administrator (Lay Employee) Mrs Susan Jackson The Sale Methodist Circuit is a grouping of six churches, four of which are located in the Sale urban area. The other two churches are located outside of Sale, one in the Cheshire village and urban over-spill area of Partington, the other in the Dunham Massey conservation area at Sinderland Green.

The activities covered by the Sale Methodist Circuit in these financial statements fall within the work of The Methodist Church in Great Britain. The aim of The Methodist Church in Great Britain is to fulfil its calling, which is to respond to the gospel of God's love in Christ and to live out its discipleship in worship and mission. It does this through its Stategic objectives which are, Worship, Learning and caring, Service and Evangelism. The trustees consider that for these reasons the charity meets these public benefit requirements.

The Sale Methodist Circuit Mission Statement is: "We will encourage personal and Church growth through new and existing ventures in mission".

Public Benefit - The trustees of The Methodist Church had due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission in compliance with its duties under section 17 of the Charities Act 2011. The guidance sets out two key principles. The orginisation must have an identifiable benefit and the benefit must be to the public or a section of the public. The church exists inter alia, to: Increase awareness of God's presence and to celebrate God's love, to help people to learn and grow as Christians, through mutual support and care, and be a good neighbour to people in need and challenge injustice.

Banking Services are provided by National Westminster Bank plc and the accounts are independently examined by Mr. David Phillips.

Structure and Governance - The Sale Methodist Circuit conforms to the Structure and Governance of The Methodist Church of Great Britain.

The Sale Methodist Circuit is a constituent part of the Manchester and Stockport District of the Methodist Church of Great Britain. Sale Methodist Circuit is registered charity number 1151757

Management of Circuit business is conducted by means of the Circuit Meeting, which has Managing Trustees powers and responsibilities for Circuit property: 3 Cheltenham Drive, Sale; 4 The Willows, Manor Avenue, Sale; 16 Lock Lane, Partington; Carrington Lane Methodist Church and The Trinity Bowling and Sports Club grounds on Temple Road, Sale.

In addition to the Circuit meeting, the following meetings are held throughout the year: Leadership Team, Staff meetings, Finance, Safeguarding, Manse Property, Local Preachers and Worship Leaders.

In addition to the members of the Meeting, the Circuit Administrator, *Mrs Susan Jackson*, attends Circuit Meeting as Circuit Secretary but is not a member of the Meeting. The Circuit Meeting has met on 4 occasions during the financial year.

At 1st November 2018 the recorded membership of the Circuit was 259. During the October 2018 Congregation Count average Sunday attendance at worship in the Churches of the Circuit was: 195

During the 12 months under review the Circuit has continued to resource the churches of the Circuit by supplying preachers and leaders of public worship through the quarterly preaching Plan. The Circuit staff team has encouraged and faciliated the coming together of the Churches in task specific groups for mutual support and planning. In particular the Circuit has convened Church Council Secretaries, Treasurers, and Property officers to give guidance on administrative matters. Circuit and Church Safeguarding officers and Circuit Staff have worked together to roll out a consistent implementation of Safeguarding policies and their procedures across the Circuit. This work is on-going. The Circuit has also encouraged all the Churches of the Circuit to engage in reviews in order to better evaluate and plan for the tasks of the local churches and to identify priority points for the focus of Circuit commitments. Again the work of local church reviews, encompasing the Circuit Mission Statement, are on-going.

Accounts for the year 2018-19, together with notes, are included in this Annual Report. A Finance and Reserves Policy Statement is also attached.
