## STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The St John The Baptist Greek Orthodox Trust is constituted as an unincorporated charity, the activities of which are governed by a trust deed dated 16th November, 1984.

The trustees oversee and authorise all expenditure of the charity as well as the main fund raising events, such as the Christmas raffle.

The school is run by the school committee, its chairman and the headmaster.

The ladies association is run by its own appointed committee and chairwoman.
