Director's Summary



Our 2018/19 year has been extremely busy. There are now 73 young people who have benefitted directly from The Noah Initiative programme in Kenya. We are also very happy to report that 7 young people have graduated from the programme, becoming self-reliant and either employed or self-employed. As well as the young people on the programme we are also making a significant impact through our mentorship network which currently supports over 50 single parents. This is helping more people in the poorest communities around Eldoret to learn new skills, become self- supporting and able to sustain their family group.

During the year we have had a number of fundraising activities across the UK and are encouraged to have been able to expand our network of supporters geographically. It is really important to us that, as the organisation grows in impact, we also grow our network of committed supporters. We also hope that in the coming year The Noah Society (Kenyan Branch of The Noah Initiative) can be supported to start income generating projects.


