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TRUSTEES' REPORT

The Trustees of the Bishop Seth Ward Almshouse Trust Charity present their annual report, together with the accounts for the year ended 31st December 2019 and confirm they comply with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011, the Trust Deed, and the Charities SORP as they apply to smaller charities.

Objectives and activities

The objective of the Bishop Seth Ward Almshouse Trust is to help house underprivileged mature adults in Buntingford, Hertfordshire. The Trust invests in properties to raise funds to support the running and maintenance of the Almshouses.

Trustees

The Trustees are responsible for the overall management and control of the Charity. All Trustees give their time freely with remuneration paid in the year for the secretarial and treasury functions. The trustees who held office during the year to 31st December 2019 were;

Financial Review

The accounts show an overall surplus in the year of $\pounds 36,924$. Income was consistent with 2018 but maintenance costs decreased significantly on both the Almshouses and Chapel End properties.

Achievements and performance

The Trust continues to provide housing for mature adults on a low income in the local community. The Trustees were able to significantly reduce the outgoings this year and increase the financial reserves to support the long-term plans.

Future plans

The Trustees intend to continue their current strategies of maintaining the property and utilising the income from their investments to fund projected repairs of $\pounds 30,000$ to the Almshouses, along with the long-term plan to replace the roof of the building which is estimated to be around $\pounds 500,000$. The Trust will continue to review its aims and objectives to ensure the Almshouses are affordable and attractive within the community.
