IT WAS DECIDED TO MAKE THE DONATIONS STRAIGHT AWAY BECAUSE THE PANDEMIC IS AFFECTING ALL THOSE WITH PANCREATIC CANCER AND THOSE THAT TREAT THEM.
MARK CHURCH HAS ALSO SPENT THE YEAR BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS WITH HOSPICES AND HAS ALSO DONE VOLUNTARY WORK. BY DOING THIS IT PROVIDES THE FOUNDATION AND THE TRUSTEES WITH THE INFORMATION REQUIRED TO MAKE AN INFORMED DECISION ON WHERE OUR NEXT DONATION WILL BE GOING.
