St Joseph's Pre-school is a member of the Early Years Alliance and follows their guidance with regards to key policy documents and procedures. We are also a member of Bristol and Neighbourhood Daycare (BAND).and receive guidance and support from them also, as well as the LEA Teacher Advisory Service.

The pre-school is registered with Ofsted and meets all statutory and regulatory requirements for the provision of day care for under five year olds.

The Committee and Trustees are elected annually and is largely made up of parent/carers who use the services we provide. The trustees give their time voluntarily to support the pre-school.

### Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Continuing to provide care and education to under 5yr olds serving over fifty families in the local community. The dedicated Two year old Room continues to go well. Staffing numbers have remained consistent and over the past twelve months the staff have continued with various in house and external training and are all keen and willing to continue doing these courses so that they can all keep up to date with the ever increasing changes in childcare. This includes a fourth staff member now embarking on their Level 5 Foundation degree and two others commencing their L3.

We have had less volunteers this year but continue with a good stream of students who are here to do much needed training and some who have chosen to keep volunteering on completion of training too as well as a steady stream of other short term student placements. Volunteers give up their valuable time and support to the children and pre-school and it is much appreciated.

We have continued to work on the local accreditation scheme called the 'Bristol Standard' and place high importance on ongoing self-evaluation and reflective practice to ensure the pre-school is the best that it can be. Our financial stability has been maintained in the last year though other running costs are still rising and we are depending more and more on fund raising to try and replace some of our tired and worn out equipment. As a not-for-profit run group who try to keep fees as low as possible, we really do look to parents and friends to support us in this so any ideas, help or even company sponsorship to support us would be greatly appreciated.

We have continued to try to build stronger links with parents to improve the learning opportunities for the children and to celebrate the learning that goes on both here and at home. This continues to be a strong focus as parental participation in children's learning underlies our core principles as a Community run group!
