#### STRUCTURE AND GOVERNANCE

The Charity is governed by a Constitution dated 13 May 2007. Membership is open to any baptised and chrismated Orthodox Christian over the age of 18 who supports its Objects and who has paid a voluntary membership subscription.

The Trustees are elected by the members for a period of 2 years.

The Trustees meet at least 4 times per year

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

The objects of the Community are the advancement of the Orthodox Christian faith and traditions as contained in Holy Scripture, as practised in the life of the church, as confirmed by the Oecumenical and local Councils and as interpreted, preserved and taught by the great Church of Christ, the Oecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople ("the Objects").

In the period the Charity continued to provide services in the Orthodox Tradition at The Chapel, The Cemetery, Clifton Road, Rugby CV21 3QW.

#### FINANCIAL REVIEW AND FUTURE STRATEGY

The healthy surplus recorded in the financial statements is due to differences in cashflow timing between this and the previous financial year in respect of Gift Aid receipts and refurbishment expenditure. The Trustees consider the accounts to represent a balanced and accurate view of the financial state of the Community. However, they are conscious that whilst monthly cash flow remains at break-even level, accumulated reserves are becoming unreasonably high given the Objects of the Community.

The Trustees' underlying primary financial objectives of attaining at least an operational break-even position at the end of each financial year and of maintaining reserves at a level equivalent to at least one Quarter's foreseen expenditure remain unchanged. However, refurbishments and repairs to the church fabric planned to take place during the coming year are expected to reduce reserves to a level closer to the Charity Commission's guidelines.
