For the public benefit, the prevention or relief of poverty in remote communities in Nepal and the provision of education for disadvantaged children in Nepal by providing grants, items and services to individuals in need and/or other charities or organisations working to achieve those objectives.

The Trustees are aware of the guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission and have taken this into account in planning their activities for the year under review.

The main activity undertaken for the public benefit in the year under review has been the granting of donations to TTSF Nepal to help fund the construction of a new community hall at Saisima in Nepal. Once completed, this building will support the education of disadvantaged children in the area. Considerable progress has been made with the construction of the community hall and several of the Trustees have been to visit the project (at their own expense) to see the work undertaken so far. It is hoped that phase one of this project will be completed in 2020 after which work will begin on a linked kitchen and dormitory facility.
