## AUDITORS NOTES

The Francis Baily PTA accounts for 2018-19 are again organised and in good order. Accounts examined this year include the 200 Club and PayPal as well as the main bank account. The use of the accounting software adopted last year continues to improve the accuracy and efficiency of preparation of the PTA accounts. The 200 Club has now been closed and the final funds from the 200 Club bank account were transferred to the main PTA bank account. The PTA have really had a bumper year this year with fundraising profits of £21,982 - this is a £10,000 increase year on year.

New events such as Happy's Circus and the collaboration with Kennet School PTA for the Fireworks Night along with matched funding have allowed significant donations to the school this year. Most notably, 50 new Chromebooks have been purchased along with contributions to the new school website and the grassing of the new Foundation area whilst annual pantomime, author visits and support for the Year 6 Leavers BBQ continue The bank balance remains at a healthy level at the start of the new school year and operating costs remain at a sensible level which should allow for another successful year of fundraising.
