## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The number of pupils is constant: around 91 pupils with 6 teachers and 4 teachers assistants.

The school carried on using the grant from the AEFE (French Foreign Affairs department) of £7,755 received the year before to purchase new school books, new books for the library and some promotion leaflets.

The GCSE class has increased in number from 6 to 11 pupils and offers bespoke tuition to older students. Their results were outstanding.

The trustees and management team have received training and advice on the running of a school from Parapluie FLAM, NRCSE and the Enfield safeguarding board.

The teachers and management team are encouraged to attend the regular workshops offered by the association of French supplementary schools "Parapluie FLAM" in order to share ideas and best practice.

The main sources of funds of Un Matin Francais are the tuition fees paid by the families and the school membership donations.

We also organised fund raising events in the form of school fetes.

Using the MyDonate platform allowed the school to apply gift aid to the donations and increase its total donations by 24%.

We have not increased our tuition fees this year which remain at £100 per pupil per term for the first 5 classes and £200 for GCSE pupils.

We offer a discount of 10% to siblings and 30% to children who qualify for the Pupil Premium Grant or School Free Meal scheme at their own primary school.

Funds go towards the remuneration of staff, the rental costs of the premises, the purchase of school supplies and management fees.
