Trustees report April 2019 – April 2020.

The green remains in good condition. Last year's resurfacing of the area in front of Rose Cottage, and defining its length with a marker post has greatly reduced vehicle damage in this on this part of The Green, the existing damage has been made good using dirty hardcore and surplus turf supplied by a member of the group. Damage due to vehicles driving off the side of the track across the green remains a problem and has been made good on two occasions during the year. Further verge damage by a commercial vehicle opposite Hopefield cottages was made good by a friend of the group using turf which was overgrowing a local footpath.

At the AGM in November Yvonne Miller resigned as secretary, and was replaced by Tracey Walker. Yvonne is leaving the village to move closer to family. Yvonne was thanked for making the whole green project possible by donating The Green to the village and her work and advice in setting up the charity.

Linda Howarth formally resigned as a foundation trustee and was replaced by Christopher Harrison.

The appearance of The Green continues to improve and the content and biodiversity of the wild flower areas continues to improve. Some of the yellow rattle sown on "the triangle" has germinated and we now have several patches which will hopefully reduce grass growth. This is encouraging and further seed will be collected locally and sown immediately in several prepared patches.

The annual clearance of the wildflower areas was carried out at very short notice at the end of October when a weather window presented itself in what had been a very wet autumn. Because of the short notice the clearance involved only four members of The Group.

The well has been cleaned out and generally tidied up, and is now draining freely.

Four oak trees supplied by a village resident have been planted in the rough area protected by tree shields. One of them replaced a rowan tree which was destroyed by bark damage caused by deer.

We have received £250 from the K-B walk. No other grant applications have been made as The Group has sufficient funds for its needs.
