Objectives and Activities

To further or benefit the residents of the Newtown district in Cambridge city, without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions by associating together the said residents and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort of improving the conditions of life for the residents.

The objectives and activities are all designed for the public benefit as set out in the guidance issued by the charity commission.

Achievements and Performance

The Signal Box had another thriving year, with little change from the previous year in terms of its focus and management. Three broad areas of general achievement are of particular importance.

Firstly, there has been a wide range of regular groups and activities using the two rooms, including activities for all ages, involving music, dance, arts, sports, health and much more. All of these activities were held on a weekly basis throughout the year with good attendance.

Secondly, the Signal Box has made a concerted effort to host a range of community events and activities, all run on a donation basis, with emphasis on providing a hub for the whole community, while providing additional support for activities for children, young people and vulnerable or isolated local residents.

Thirdly, children's birthday and Christmas parties remain particularly popular. There is always positive feedback from parents about how good the venue is for parties.

Financial Review

Essentially, all the finances needed to run the Signal Box are generated from room hiring. In the current year, we were particularly grateful for a grant of £322 from Cambridge City Council to support Christmas events for children and parents.

It is the policy of the Signal Box to hold reserves of £15,000 to manage cash flow and to provide for emergencies.

The Signal Box generated a surplus of £4,459 for the reporting year, such that funds of £4,715 in excess of the minimum reserve were held at the year end. This small excess provides the charity with the cash needed for painting, decorating and other maintenance work planned for early 2020.

Structure, Governance and Management

The Signal Box is a registered Charity and its constitution is that of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation.

The Trustees meet several times a year to oversee the governance and management of the charity. Four part-time employees deal with the day-to-day operations.
