Annual Treasurer's Report:

The NPSA is the parent and teacher fundraising body for Newbridge Primary School, Bath, UK. The Association's aims are to advance the education of the pupils by providing and assisting in the provision of facilities for education at the school. In doing so it provides opportunities for parents and local community to get involved with fun activities at the school, and raises funds for 'extra' items outside of the main school budget. The NPSA Trustees meet approximately once every month to vote on funding requests made by the school's Senior Management team, and the wider NPSA membership meet once every two months to plan events.

This year Amy Osborne continued as Chair while she seeks a replacement for next academic year.

The NPSA has recently formed a Grants & Fundraising team who have worked up a 5 year "Wellbeing" plan with the School's Senior Leadership Team, so we have a clear plan for grant applications and spending of those grants in line with our plans to bring learning outside, and create more useable spaces on our large site.

This year was another record-breaking fundraising year for the NPSA, raising £31,551 and over £34,000 was donated to school projects.

The starting balance in September 2018 was £30,984 and the finishing balance on 31st August 2019 was £25,675.

The larger donations to the school in 2018-19 were also for a subscription to Jigsaw which is a PSHE curriculum, a sound system in the Upper School hall, two new interactive whiteboards, laptops and maths resources. This year the NPSA funded the first ever Newbridge Primary School science week – which involved lessons during school and a fair at the weekend both of which were free for all the children and the wider community, organized by parent volunteers and bringing in local science companies and education institutions. It was a huge hit with the teachers and the children, and cost £1,130. Our final large expenditure was £6,000 payment to school to which we attached no conditions, the funds were needed by the SLT.

The NPSA also continued to fund regular commitments such as half the cost of Forest School and the annual Twinkl subscription, which provides invaluable classroom resources for teachers to use. The contributions towards school trips in all year groups and snacks for SATS pupils continued. The NPSA also pays for important Life Skills training for Year 6 pupils as well as a payment towards their leaving gift.

The NPSA spent £463 on asset purchases – these items included an urn, some trolleys, a hoover and other consumables.

As usual we paid an advance fee to secure a fireworks display for the following year and 10 places at the 2019 Bath half marathon. We have given these places to 10 parents each of whom need to raise £250 for the NPSA.

We would like to thank all parents for supporting our fundraising efforts – especially our Bath Half runners!

Finally, our reserves policy has remained the same. We are keeping two years' worth of regular school commitments in our Santander account. On 31 August 2019 there was £16,6225 in this account, which is equivalent to approximately £8,000 a year. This is to safeguard the basic commitments we have made to school in the case of a severe downturn in fundraising if for example the NPSA has a lack of volunteers or events don't raise the high amounts they have recently.
