

## Trustees Report to the Charity Commission

### Lincoln Cat Care 2019-2020

When Lincoln Cat Care was granted charitable status in 2004 its declared aim was to promote humane behaviour towards cats by providing appropriate treatment and security to those in need of care, through reason of sickness, malnutrition, poor circumstances and abuse; to educate the public in matters pertaining to cat welfare and to prevent cruelty and suffering to cats.

The Trustees are satisfied that these principles still hold true and that this charity achieves the best it can with the resources available.

2019-2020 has been a similar year to the last one. Again we have paid for, partly or wholly, over 1566 veterinary procedures. The neutering scheme involved 548 queens and toms. We covered the cost of 33 xrays, 37 dental operations and 56 cats needing hospitalisation. 19 cats received treatment for road traffic accidents. On the advice of vets 33 cats were euthanized. Several hundred of these cases were unhomeed cats which would otherwise have received no support and many of which have subsequently been rehomed. Lincoln Cat Care have found homes for 252 cats and kittens this year. We have endeavoured to ensure that cats receive the treatment they need.

The Trustees would like to thank the many kind people who support the Charity. Both volunteers and donors enable LCC to help make life better for cats in need.
