Chairman of the trustees annual report 2018-19

The year saw the very sad passing of our former chairman of the trustees Dr. Stuart Marston, a role he had held since 2008, Stuart's passion for the charities' objectives together with specialist insight from his career as a veterinary surgeon were incredibly valuable to all at the charity. Stuart had dedicated much of his time and energy to the fight for animal welfare and to see as many dogs rescued and rehomed in loving care as possible, we will continue the great work that was started by Stuart as one of our founding members.

The number of dogs rehomed increased again this year to 237. The trustees decided to invest in a canopy to provide cover in front of the kennels, to provide shelter to the visitors looking to rehome the dogs on our open days. The Wednesday and Sunday opening days continue to be very worthwhile and the management of visitors is regularly reviewed and optimised for the health and safety of both visitors and the dogs in residence for rehoming.

The shop continues to be the main source of income and the staff continue to provide high standards and levels of service which keep the operation busy and revenues stable. We have also seen continued generous donations from TUI.

The revenue decrease was offset by a reduction in professional fees, with less treatment required by the dogs in our care against the previous year. Reserves therefore increased slightly enabling us to continue helping many hundreds of dogs receive treatment and find a new life. The trustees regularly review all expenditure to manage the finances and optimise the scope of the charities goals.

The relentless enthusiasm and dedication of all of the volunteers and staff at EMDR are testament to the success and reputation of the charity.
