All proceeds were transferred to France for inclusion in the Congregational Common Fund so that the resources of the Congregation throughout the world would be amalgamated under one administration.

The Trustees shall hold the Trust Fund and the income therefrom trust to apply the same either as capital or income for such charitable purposes which advance the religious and other charitable work for the time being carried on in England by or under the direction of the Order as the Trustees within the meaning of the Charities Act 1960.

The trustees shall hold at least two ordinary meetings in each year. A special meeting may be summoned at any time by the chairwoman or any two Trustees upon not less than four days' notice being given to the other Trustees of the matters to be discussed.

The policy is to ensure sufficient reserves are carried to meet all anticipated commitments during the year.


The final balance of the English Congregation at 31 December 2019 totalled £382,134 (2018: £384,317). Net movement of funds transferred from the accumulated fund totalled £2,183 (2018: transfers from the fund £9,054).

There were net outgoing resources amounting to £2,183 (2018: net outgoing resources £9,054). The income and expenditure for the year were as expected, income £44,702 (2018 - £37,508) and expenditure £46,562 (2018 - £46,562).

The freehold and leasehold land and properties are stated at cost. No provision has been made in the accounts for depreciation of properties. Whilst this is not in accordance with the accounting standards, any depreciation charge would not be significant. The properties are maintained to acceptable standards and the trustees consider that the cost of obtaining a full professional valuation of the properties would not be justifiable.

**Tangible fixed assets and depreciation**

Governing costs include those costs directly incurred in complying with the statutory obligations of managing the charity.

Charitable activities are those costs directly incurred in the provision of services and supporting the Order in their pastoral work in the UK. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of indirect nature necessary to support them. The charity also supports the work of the Congregation throughout the rest of the world.

VAT which cannot be fully recovered and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes any VAT which can be fully recovered and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

**Resources expended**

With the exception of voluntary income, which is included in the statement of financial activities when received, all income is credited to the statement of financial activities when it becomes receivable.
