## NOTE OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 9 SEPTEMBER 2019 AT MAGPIE COTTAGE, MURTHERING LANE, STAPLEFORD ABBOTTS, ROMFORD RM4 1HT

#### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the previous meeting were taken as read and agreed.

#### REPORT OF JOANNE BEECHAM, CHAIRPERSON

We are still taking in cats and kittens that are abandoned, either as a result of peoples' ignorance in not neutering their cats, or of changes in peoples' circumstances meaning that they are unable to care for them. In some cases the cats we have taken into the centre are not able to be re-homed due to their aggressive or unsociable behaviour, and will remain with us for their lifetime. For this reason we are always over-subscribed with cats waiting to come into the centre. We would welcome new volunteers to foster cats and kittens, which would in due course be permanently re-homed.

This year I have done a lot of trapping with feral colonies. Luckily in most cases I have been able to trap, neuter and return them. This is only possible when I am assured that the cats will be fed, provided with shelter and monitored for any future health problems. When ferals cannot be returned and there are no suitable homes for them, they live out their lives here with me enjoying comfort, food and freedom.

Homing is still very slow, cats and kittens end up staying months in our care until the right home comes along.

Funds are as always a concern, since we no longer have our charity shop, but for the time being we will carry on doing as much as we can.

### REPORT OF FREDERICK DOODY, TREASURER

The Charity's current account with Lloyds Bank was in credit by £22,175 on 5 September 2019. The figure represents an increase of £18,915 since August last year, which is accounted for by the receipt of two substantial legacies. £20,000 was donated to the charity by the estate of the late Joan Howard and a further £3,000 was received from the estate of the late Gillian Aspinall. The trustees of Cat Rescue

would like to put on record their sincere thanks and appreciation for these generous gifts. The savings account, which is also with Lloyds Bank, was in credit by £9,165 on 9 August 2019.

Since the closure of the Wood Street shop in August 2015, the Charity's expenditure significantly exceeds its income. As a consequence, the Charity is having to utilise it's savings and investments in order to continue with its activities. The charity is extremely fortunate to receive regular monthly contributions from individuals that totalled £1,200 in 2019. This is a significant amount of regular income, which greatly benefits the work of the charity. In recognition of this, the trustees would like to thank the individuals concerned, namely Miss J Pindelska, J Western, Angela Morgan, William Howard, Mr & Mrs Doody, H Cummins, F Prust, B J Parsons and Tracy Collier.

The Charity's investment with Old Mutual Wealth totalled £112,942 on 5 July 2019, an increase of £6,162 since 5 April 2018. It must be recognised, however, that as this investment depends on the performance of stocks and shares, its value can fall as well as rise. The investment should be regarded as a long term investment, however at some point it will almost certainly be necessary to transfer some of the investment back into the current account in order to cover regular expenses such as boarding and vets bills.  $\cdot$ 

#### **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

The meeting concluded with the Trustees agreeing that Cat Rescue must continue with the good work of feline welfare and re-homing that has built up since the Charity started.
