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

The course is delivered by us, within a partnering school and requires each child to undertake a short application process in order to participate. The applications provide the Streets Ahead team valuable insight into each child's individual aspirations and fears and, as a result, we'll have a better idea of where the group is as a whole, before we begin delivering the course.

The course itself has been carefully designed (in conjunction with industry experts) to have a lasting impact on all participants who commit to it with an open and optimistic mindset.

Throughout the module we aim to challenge one major idea about success that is commonly held by young people from economically disadvantaged backgrounds: that success is something that happens to other people.

The rest of the course is then ultimately about showing and teaching each participant that, if they want to, they can take control of their future and achieve their own version of success.
