Executive Summary

Established in 1999 as the Lighthouse Project, The Amethyst Foundation Is a UK charity set up to umbrella projects serving the health and wellbeing need of families. We registered with the charity commission in 2015.

Our aims as set out in the constitution are:

- To provide Befriending, family/parent UK breaks, Information and Workshops for Parents.
- To provide information and support to parent/carers who have a child or young adult with SLCN (speech, language and communication needs).
- To promote the parent/carer's knowledge and awareness of speech, language and communication needs by carrying out research, publishing guidance and resource documents, and delivering training and workshops.
- To promote the health and wellbeing of the parent/carer through counselling support and befriending. To relieve burdens and breakdown of parent/carers who have a child with speech, language and communication needs through home visiting and home group support.

Activities, Achievements & Performance

Parent Friends is a one of our projects based in London set up to support parents who have a child with speech and language impairments. On the 21st January 2016, working in partnership with AFAISIC, we delivered a Speech and Language workshop to parents, carers and teachers at our Canalside offices, London W10.

We delivered three more forums that year with guest speakers , covering the following topics :

- Allergy Tree – 28th January 2016
- Understanding the care Act and disability – 3rd February, 2016
- Nutritional foods and their benefits – 3rd May 2016
- Budgeting – 19th November 2016 at St. Luke's Church
- Health and wellness – NHS and Amethyst Talking therapy – 12th March 2017
- Meet and greet – Starbucks, Brent Civic centre – periodically

In addition to workshops and forums, we have, With the help of our volunteers, achieved the following:

- Collaborated and partnered with other organisations to serve several parents via One to One, Local Groups and events services and projects.
- Represented Parents in Brent to replace old transport buses with the more newer model transport buses for their children to ride to and from school.
- Partnered with professional resources bodies to provide up to date information for families pertaining to their child's need.
- Set up three donating sites to appeal for our charity causes
