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The Trustees, who are also directors for the purposes of company law, have pleasure in presenting their report and the financial statements for the charitable company for the year ended 31 December 2019. The Trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

### Objectives and aims

The objects of the Charity are to educate, inform the public in the dramatic and operatic arts and to further the development of public appreciation and taste in said arts. To promote the youth within the general community in the production of dramatic, operatic and musical arts. To provide an inclusive facility for the public to be part of a community group and be able to use and develop various skills. To provide aid for the public benefit urban and/or rural regeneration in areas of social and economic deprivation and in particular in the OL13 area ("the area of benefit") by the following means:

- a. To raise funds and invite and receive contributions from any person or persons whatsoever by way of subscription, donation and otherwise.
- b. To donate such funds to other charitable body as surplus profits allow as the Trustees may decide
- c. To do all such things as shall further the objects of the charity including but not exclusively:
- I. The advancement of education, training or retraining, particularly amongst the young the unemployed people, those who may be social disenfranchised and those with special needs. By providing unemployed people with work experience in the world. By providing an escape from poverty
- II. The maintenance and preservation of an historical building which is a community asset for the people of Rossendale and the only facility of its kind in the locality. Thereby increasing and improving the provision of public amenities by making the building available for other community and charitable events

The trustees have considered the Charity Commision's guidance on public benefit, including the guidance 'public benefit: running a charity (PB2)'.

Community engagement, capacity building and public benefit

2019 was a busy year. Highlights of the year were:

- · We continue to develop and grow our youth section. The original youth section BYTES (Bacup Youth Theatre Entertainment Society) continues to gain members and 2017 saw it celebrate its 20th anniversary in 2017. Our new after schools group BEST continues to gain momentum.
- · On Easter Saturday Bacup is show-cased with its traditional boundary to boundary "Coconutters" dance. The theatre participated with a number of activities including face painting, craft stalls, we also provided refreshments via the bar and coffee bars and the Coconutters danced on stage. The theatre is the only indoor venue where people could watch if the weather was inclement.
- · Once again we took part in the local annual carnival "BASCO" (Bacup and Stacksteads Carnival Organisation).
- · We have provided a huge range of volunteering opportunities in a wide range of areas for sections of the local community, this year a decision was made that volunteers would no longer have to pay a fee to be a member.

We have continued to work colabarately and be in dialogue with other local groups and organisations.

### Constitution and Governance

- · We ensured all our volunteers were correctly trained in health and safety procedures and we have held fire evacuation procedures and have had a thank you night for our volunteers where refreshments were provided and awards handed out.
