#### **OBJECTIVES**

The Charity's objectives are to promote, for the benefit of the inhabitants of Wombleton and the surrounding area, the provision of facilities for recreational or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interests of social welfare and with object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants.

### **ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

During the year the Charity organised a bonfire on the village playing field, a Race Night and various other fundraising events. The Charity maintains a playground, tennis courts and playing fields. These facilities are open to all residents and visitors to the village.

#### **PUBLIC BENEFIT**

The Trustees have had due regard to guidance published by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

### **RESERVES POLICY**

The Charity aims to maintain cash reserves of around £2,000 which approximates to 1 year's operational costs. At present the Charity's cash reserves are £11,589. Reserves are being held to fund the ongoing work to the new pavilion.

### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

## 1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

Wombleton Sports & Recreation Club Limited is a company limited by guarantee in England / Wales. In the event of the charity being wound up, the liability in respect of the guarantee is limited to £1 per member of the charity. The address of the registered office is given in the charity information on page 1 of these financial statements. The nature of the charity's operations and principal activities are include in the Trustee Report.

The charity constitutes a public benefit entity as defined by FRS 102. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) issued on 16 July 2014 (as updated through Update Bulletin 1 published on 2 February 2016), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102), the Charities Act 2011, the Companies Act 2006 and UK Generally Accepted Accounting Practice.

The financial statements are prepared on a going concern basis under the historical cost convention, modified to include certain items at fair value. The financial statements are presented in sterling which is the functional currency of the charity and rounded to the nearest  $\mathfrak L$ .

The significant accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented unless otherwise stated

#### 1.2 Income

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities when the Charity is entitled to the income, any performance conditions have been met, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

For donations to be recognised the charity will have been notified of the amounts and the settlement date in writing. If there are conditions attached to the donation and this requires a level of performance before entitlement can be obtained then income is deferred until those conditions are fully met or the fulfilment of those conditions is within the control of the charity and it is probable that they will be fulfilled

## 1.3 Expenses

Expenditure is recognised on an accruals basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes any VAT which cannot be fully recovered and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

## 1.4 Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity.

Designated funds are funds earmarked for a particular purpose by the trustees. They form part of unrestricted funds as the designation has an administrative purpose only and does not legally restrict the trustees' discretion to apply the fund. The Charity has no designated funds as at the year end.

Restricted funds are subject to restrictions on their expenditure by the donor.

## 1.5 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of those assets over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Playground equipment – 20% straight line Assets under construction – No depreciation

## 2. LEGAL STATUS OF THE CHARITY

The Charity is a private company limited by guarantee and consequently does not have share capital. Each of the members is liable to contribute an amount not exceeding £1 towards the assets of the company in the event of liquidation.

### 3. TRUSTEES' REMUNERATION AND RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

None of the Trustees received any remuneration or expenses during the year and there were no related party transactions during the year.

## 4. TAXATION

As a Charity, Wombleton Sports & Recreation Club Limited is exempt from corporation tax on its income and gains.
