Achievements and performance

In the period February 2019 and February 2020 T J Danes Rescue has rehomed 37 dogs.

These have largely been Great Danes but also Include 1 Anatolian Shepherd

•

Our partnership with a large pet store has grown from strength to

strength. Our regular attendance at the store with our dogs, continue to

give the general public an opportunity to experience the breed and thus

raise both specific and general awareness. This also helps us to raise

funds.

We received a Grant from "Support Adoption for Pets" that enabled us to purchase a purpose built Danebulance that is critical in helping us save Great Danes.

The local radio station has continued to play an free advert about what we do.

We regularly receive between 10 and 15 expressions of interest per week

on our website. We have tightened up our response to these requests in

order to give prospective adopters the opportunity to carefully consider

such a commitment. As a result of this individuals are given the opportunity to revise their enthusiasm for the breed through an exchange

of information.

In the period under review, 73 home checks have been undertaken.

Of

these 45 have not met our criteria and been advised of this. Dogs have been placed in all parts of the country. Each and every dog who comes to us is checked by our veterinarian and appropriate treatment given where necessary. They are all neutered at

our expense.

In planning the activities for the year 2019/2020 the trustees reviewed the

Charity Committee guidance at their trustee meetings. Each of the

trustees have read the guidance.


