GOVERNING DOCUMENT

STOCKPORT MUSLIM FOUNDATION IS A LIMITED COMPANY CONSTITUTED AS A CHARITY AND REGISTERED WITH THE CHARITY COMMISSION ON 9TH OCTOBER 2015 UNDER CHARITY NUMBER 1163915. IT IS GOVERNED BY A COMPANY STRUCTURE WITH MEMORANDUM AND ARTICLES INCORPORATED IN 2013 COMPANY NUMBER 08777439.

(G) THE MONTHLY PRAYERS AS AN ACT OF REMEMBRANCE AND BLESSINGS FOR SAYYIDUNA SHEIKH ABDUL QAADIR JILANI (MAY GOD BE PLEASED WITH HIM) IN EACH ISLAMIC CALENDAR MONTH (MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS <u>GHIYARWEEN SHAREEF</u>)

(H) THE REMEMBRANCE AND CELEBRATION OF ALL THE SAINTS ACCEPTED BY MUSLIMS FOLLOWING THE HANAFI BARELVI SCHOOL OF ISLAMIC JURISPRUDENCE (MAY GOD BE PLEASED WITH THEM) (BEING COLLECTIVELY MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS <u>AULIA ALLAH</u>);

RESERVES POLICY
