

<b>1.1 Bases of preparation of accounts</b>	The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP FRSSE) (effective January 2015), the Financial Reporting Standard for smaller Entities (FRSSE) (effective January 2015) and the Companies Act 2006.
<b>1.2 Company status</b>	The company is a registered charity that is not limited by guarantee.
<b>1.3 Incoming resources</b>	All income including collections and donations are accounted for on a receipts basis. The charity has not received any grants in the year, other than those disclosed in the accounts.
<b>1.4 Cash flow</b>	The charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small charitable organisation.
<b>1.5 Fixed Assets</b>	Fixed assets are shown at historical cost and are fully depreciated on the following basis:-
<b>1.6 Tax and VAT status</b>	St. Peter's Italian Catholic Church is a registered charity and is not subject to tax on its activities. The charity is not registered for VAT. In common with many similar charities, St. Peter's expenses are inflated by VAT which cannot be recovered.
