2019 Annual Report

This year marked the Orchestra's 25th Anniversary which was celebrated by a special Silver Jubilee Concert on Sunday 3rd November at the Cadogan Hall in London, attended by a near capacity audience.

100 young players from schools all over the country assembled at Haberdashers' Aske's School, Hertfordshire, for the orchestral course that began on Wednesday 30th October.

The Orchestra opened the concert with Elgar's Cockaigne Overture (In London Town). They were then joined by the exciting young pianist Isata Kanneh-Mason for a performance of the Clara Schumann Piano Concerto. Isata, a BBC Young Musician of the Year finalist, had just released a highly acclaimed recording of this piece with the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra and the ESO were delighted to be able to work with her at such a key moment in her rapidly developing career. After the interval the Orchestra gave an exhilarating account of Rachmaninov's Second Symphony, surely one of the most popular late Romantic pieces in the repertoire.

Under the auspices of the ESO Charity The English Young Artists' Sinfonia performed to a packed St Bartholomew's Church in the City Music Festival in February. In July they were invited to present an open air event at Moat Farm in Lingfield Surrey, sponsored by Alex Jones. The generous proceeds went to the ARNIE stroke charity and to local causes. Over 400 spectators enjoyed a popular programme and picnics under clear skies. The evening culminated with a spectacular fireworks display

ESO members were also invited to perform at several events in the City of London, including once again the Pickwick Club Dinner, the League of Mercy annual awards ceremony at The Mansion House and the annual awards ceremony of the Royal Chartered Institute for Further Education at Apothecaries Hall.
