The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5 April 2020.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The governing document of Grantham Muslim Community Association is a constitution dated 17 March 2013. The trustees who served during the period are set out on page 1. The trustees are appointed by consensus of members of Grantham Muslim Community.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

- A. The advancement of the Islamic religion by providing a designated place of worship for Muslim residents be they male, female, young, elderly or disabled.
- B. The promotion of education by such means as appropriate including working with the local council, schools and other local organisations to deliver education.
- C. The promotion of health by providing information and raising awareness on a wide range of issues affecting people's health and safety.
- D. The promotion of religious harmony for the benefit of the public in particular by providing education and information on Islam and social issues for both Muslims and non-Muslims.
- E. The provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interest of social welfare and with the object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants

ACHIEVEMENTS, PERFOMRANCE

The trustees consider that the charity has had a satisfactory year, Donations collected have been used to meet the charity's objectives, in particular for the promotion of education. The Sleaford Front building work has been completed and it is being used for prayers and social gatherings. There is still ongoing work carried out to the back section with the money held in unrestricted reserves. The Grantham Community have also been able to get a building to use as their community centre and are trying to complete the initial phase to enable the building for its intended use.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Some of Sleaford branch's reserve brought forward were used to fund the repairs and maintenance in respect of the place of worship as mentioned above. Overheads are minimal and all expenses made supported the charity's objectives.
