OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

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We work with adult traumatic brain survivors (18 and over), their families and careers in West London as they leave hospital and begin their rehabilitation process & ensure vulnerable, isolated brain injured survivors do not fall through the net. Our aim is to help them achieve their full potential by providing support, expert advice and signposting them to targeted training to enable them to return to work & health and wellbeing. We have continued our service at the St Mary's and Charing Cross hospitals. Our link workers offer signposting advice and guidance across the trauma pathway from hospital ward to community

We have further expanded our day support group service which is being run by our two part-time link workers and volunteers. We have continued to organize social and fundraising activities.

We recruited a second support worker to support our outreach work in the community and he has piloted a joint project with Chelsea FC Foundation focusing on health and wellbeing.

We provide information via our website, newsletters, Facebook, twitter and our support groups.
