#### **TREASURER'S REPORT 2019**

This year the Church has seen a significant reduction in its assets – largely due to the cost of £158,000 of restoration work to both the south and north sides of the Church. Together with the £83,000 expenditure in 2018 this brings the total cost of the restoration to £241,000. There just remains now work on the north-west buttress at a cost of £4,000 to complete the project.

Our thanks go to a large number of donors and organisations – both large and small – who helped us raise the capital for this work. The Church itself sold investments held in the CBF Church of England Investment Fund to the value of £77,000 in its own contribution to the project.

There have been a number of positive financial developments during the year. We raised £8,500 – with further commitments to come – to enable the first stage of the complete renovation of the 17<sup>th</sup> century Benefactions Board; we continued our monthly fund-raising lunches, raising £1,400 for St Basils, with a similar sum for our own Church Restoration Project; we supported Alcester Café, Practical Action, Shelter, Sightsavers, and Smile Train to the extent of £400 each as part of our Outreach Giving; and we provided £4,000 from within our 2019 budget to support the internal re-decoration of the Church to take place in 2020.

We had unfortunately 3 claims to be made to our insurers during the year.

- 1. A claim for damage to the Church wall and adjoining pillar caused by vehicle impact in 2018
- 2. Damage to both the Church and Church House occasioned by intruders, and
- 3. The cost of repairs to a collapsed drain at Verger's Lodge.

The total cost of these claims was £9,500. We were able to obtain re-imbursement of 75% from our insurers.

Finally, one concern that we had during 2019 (and which remains currently on-going) is the reduction in regular giving to the Church in comparison to the figure for 2018. Donations made through stewardship, weekly envelopes, and collections on the Plate totalled £55,000 – a drop of almost 10% compared to the previous year. In response to this the PCC has moved to adopt the Parish Giving Scheme as the preferred method of giving for the Church to begin in 2020.
