The object of the charity is to provide facilities for the inhabitants of Hatch Beauchamp Parish for recreation and leisure in the interest of social welfare. These facilities should aim to improve the condition of life for the inhabitants.

The land and buildings specified in the scheme schedule are held in trust to be used for the above objective.

	The trustees maintain the village hall building and the grounds including a multi use games area (MUGA) and children's playground. A booking system is in place so that local societies can make use of the hall rooms and grounds for their activities. These organisations arrange for example W.I. meetings, bridge club, cricket club, dancing classes, Italian language classes, advanced motorists meetings, theatrical and social events. A local produce market is held monthly in the hall.
