## REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2020

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2020. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

#### Objectives and aims

To advance the musical education of the public at large but not by reason of those who are elderly, young or have by reason of social or economic circumstances through the provision of classes and performance. We believe the charity has fulfilled its objectives since registration.

#### ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

#### Charitable activities

The charity believes that it has fulfilled its objectives, with the support of grants received. It hopes that the current year provides the services to even a greater number of individuals.

The charity has completed an Inventory of purchased and donated instruments and music equipment, this has not been included in the accounts but the value of these items is £11,760.

#### FINANCIAL REVIEW

#### **Reserves policy**

The Trustees aim to keep the reserves of the charity sufficient to cover six months of resources expanded.

The charity currently operates with minimal reserves, with no specific investments other than the bank accounts. The trustees will try to increase the level of reserves. It will also, through advertising, increase students into the school, doing more fundraising in the community. This would give the charity a more secure position to further its objectives for the future.

#### **FUTURE PLANS**

We now have a dedicated grant writer on board, with her help we hope to increase funding in 2021.

Rock Star Band youth project - This is currently running , and the intermediate is to be expended.

Our new Youth Music Rock Band for beginners will be starting 31st October 2020.

We will continue to offer wellbeing project work for the over 55s.

New Sax Aerophone project work - This will be for those with Asthma and other medical diagnosed chest conditions. We are hoping to start this in the New Year 2021.

We will look into more social media coverage for the school, website, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube and Vimeo. Plus additional advertising for new project work.

The coming year may set us more challenges with Covid-19 still with us. If full lockdown happens in the next 6 months, we have made provisions to offer our students the chance to take part in online tuition, as an alternative option. Money has been put into supporting our students with Camera's and headphone, plus IT advice has been given and will continue to be offered to our students.

#### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2020

## 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

All monetary values in the accounts are presented in Sterling and all amounts are rounded to the nearest pound.

#### Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery - 25% on reducing balance

#### Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

#### Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
