#### Objectives and activities

#### Summary of the purposes of the charity set out in its governing document

To relieve poverty, hardship or distress through the provision of food to people in need of emergency supplies in York and the surrounding area and by such other means as the trustees may determine.

# Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts

The collecting of donated food by members of the public, the training of care professionals in giving out emergency food vouchers, the supporting of four local churches (Gateway Church, Living Word Church, York Community Church and York City Church) who run Foodbank sessions where vouchers can be redeemed for three days' worth of food. We continue to rely heavily on the support of a great team of volunteers who give their time to help people in need. We could not function without them.

The trustees consider that they have complied with their duties to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

#### Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity, identifying the difference the charity's work has made to the circumstances of its beneficiaries and any wider benefits to society as a whole.

This year we continued to operate at a similar level to last year for the first eleven months of the year, providing weekly sessions at four separate locations across York. In March, a dramatic spike in need coincided with the start of the Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown measures. We immediately launched a delivery service for clients who could not access our weekly sessions as a result of these measures. This late increase meant that York Foodbank received and distributed 47,339.66 kg of food. This was given out to 1,986 voucher holders, representing 2,930 adults and 2,095 children (5,025 individuals in total) over the year. This has contributed to the relief of hardship for many vulnerable families and individuals, who otherwise would have gone hungry.

#### Financial review

#### Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period

Our finances continued to remain healthy for the first eleven months of the year, with slightly increased levels of public giving and low overheads. The pandemic in March coincided with a surge in public giving which was not factored into our existing financial plans. This giving will, firstly, safeguard the foodbank's ability to meet elevated levels of need during the ongoing crisis and, secondly, facilitate the development of further initiatives to relieve poverty, hardship and distress in York and the surrounding area during the next financial year.

#### Statement explaining the policy for holding reserves stating why they are held

The trustees of York Foodbank have set an aim to have more than 3 months running costs in reserve. Because income for the charity is sporadic, reserves of up to 12 months running costs are acceptable.
