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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2019

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2019. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

FINANCIAL REVIEW

St Michaels and All Angels

The church continues to be reliant on voluntary donations for the majority of its income, with small net contributions made to the overall result made by the parish magazine, hall lettings, weddings, funerals and fundraising. Parish Giving Scheme contributions have doubled between the start and the end of the year, however still account for less than a fifth of the church's giving, with standing orders and cash donations still preferred by many members of the congregation.

Expenditure was impacted by an increase in running costs due to backdated utility costs. This is a one off and expense levels should settle next year, though it has put an extra strain on cash requirements.

The church had a net deficit in spend for 2019 and the PCC is actively reviewing opportunities for giving and fundraising to reverse this trend.

All Souls

The church hall continues to be a significant source of income for the church, though 2019 net income was impacted by major repairs expenditure.

Voluntary donations for the year were up from the previous year.

Restricted funds income increased in 2019, including a donation to create a fund towards an associate vicar, and donations to fund the war memorial conservation project.

Spend against restricted funds in 2019 included the war memorial conservation project, and the start of roof repairs which became urgent at the end of the year.

Looking forward to 2020, further commitments have been made against restricted funds to complete the roof repairs, and improve the graveyard, including fencing and pathways. Spend on the heating system is also being reviewed.

FINANCIAL REVIEW Investment policy and objectives and reserves policy Funds

As at 31 December 2019 total reserves for All Souls was £440,562, £264,433 of which is restricted as to the purpose to which the fund can be applied. This leaves unrestricted reserves of £176,129 together with further lightly restricted reserves of £36,500 that can be used for any ecclesiastical purpose in the parish.

Note that the Miss Cook Legacy endowment fund was transferred from restricted to unrestricted funds during the year with approval from the charities commission.

Total reserves for St Michaels was £214,800, of which £13,596 is restricted.

The PCC will periodically review the availability of restricted funds and where appropriate advice will be sought to amend or remove the restrictions where desirable.

RESERVES POLICY

As recommended by both the Charity Commission and Church of England guidance the Parochial Church Council has approved a reserves policy in respect of both St Michael's & All Angels church and All Souls church, which is to invest cautiously and with investments in either M & G Charifund, CCLA or similar

St Michaels & All Angels

The St Michaels policy reflects routine church running costs, service costs and cyclical building repairs and maintenance but is not intended to cover in full "1 in 100 year" items or discretionary items such as major structural repairs or improvements. Such items would be covered as far as possible by grant applications and fundraising appeals with any shortfall met from reserves. The approved policy is to hold an agreed level of investments and cash in reserve (and therefore not to include these amounts when assessing general expenditure, setting the annual budget or considering any improvement plans or special projects). The amount held in reserve will be revisited each year and is based on the most recently available annual accounts.

In respect of the year ended 31 December 2019 this reserve has been maintained at £100,000 and in setting this figure the following factors were considered.

o The age of the church and its listed building status. Whilst a number of significant building projects have been completed in the last 3 years, there are still a number of items identified in the latest quinquennial review and through discussion with the church's architect.

o The level of general expenditure incurred in the running of the Church including employee costs and the extent of recent shortfalls

o Any money received in advance in respect of the magazine

Any committed expenditure in respect of office holders and individuals who provide services on a contract basis

The list of factors to consider will be reviewed each year when the reserves policy and amount is agreed.

All Souls

The All Souls policy reflects routine church running costs, service costs and cyclical building repairs and maintenance but is not intended to cover "1 in 100 year" items such as major structural repairs or improvements. The reserve policy is intended to provide the church with the flexibility to undertake improvements to the structure and fabric of the building and to develop the facilities available as the church continues to grow and develop for the future. The approved policy is to hold an agreed level of investments and cash in reserve (and therefore not to include these amounts when assessing general expenditure and setting the annual budget). The amount held in reserve will be revisited each year and is based on the most recently available annual accounts. In respect of the year ended 31 December 2019 this reserve has been set at no less than six months unrestricted expenditure and in setting arriving at this figure the following factors were considered.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2019

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention with the exception of investments which are included at market value, as modified by the revaluation of certain assets.

Financial reporting standard 102 - reduced disclosure exemptions

The charity has taken advantage of the following disclosure exemption in preparing these financial statements, as permitted by FRS 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland':

- the requirements of Section 7 Statement of Cash Flows.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery	- At variable rates
Fixtures and fittings	 - 3 to 5 years on cost
Computer equipment	 Straight line over 4 years

Taxation

The church is exempt from tax on its charitable activities. Accordingly it is potentially exempt from taxation in respect of income and capital gains received to the extent that such income or gains are applied exclusively to charitable purposes. No provision for taxation has been made in these accounts.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the church. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Endowments funds represent capital, held in perpetuity to create income for specific purposes.
