1) FINANCIAL REPORT

The hope is they may also purchase other items whilst visiting the shop. Our plans to expand by offering more activities and services for the local community are still on-hold until we have secured new premises with appropriate capacity.

Colin was a pleasure to work with and he is sadly missed. The Chairman and other Shed members attended his funeral in February.
