- The Church activities include: Weekly Worship Services, Small Group gatherings, Prayer Meetings, Youth Life group meetings, Kids Lifegroup where people gather to share their lives together, build each other up, and help each other grow in their faith and character.
- The Church also has Outreach Events with an aim to reach out to the public like Special Event Gatherings, Street Evangelism, Basketball Tournament and Sports Day.

During Christmas and Valentine's Day, the church went out to give gifts to their neighbourhood exemplifying one of its missions which is to love neighbours.

The church also had a two-day Conference in August where the public benefited as it provided teachings of the word of God, workshops to help equip the people more and team building activities. It was an event that churches nationally and internationally were invited to join. It also catered to all groups in the public such as youth, students, children in all ages and families.
