Grants are provided to individuals who meet the conditions as outlined in the objects of the charity.

In addition, Trustees make every effort to provide assistance to the community, by way of grants to voluntary organisations in the locality.

The Trustees are mindful of the guidance provided by the Charity Commission regarding public benefit, and is reviewed annually when the report and accounts are presented at meeting.

The Trust has an Investment Policy covering investment objectives: a medium risk strategy: liquidity requirements: ethical investing: management, reporting and monitoring.

To this end, in May 2020, the Trustees updated the complaints policy. An additional grants policy was ratified in May 2020 to clarify criteria for awarding grants.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity	The Trust continues to provide assistance to individuals and organisations in the local community in line with the objects of the charity.
during the year	Trustees continue to control expenditure, and are pleased to report that around 95% of income is available for grant distribution.
	However, Trustees would prefer to see more grant applications, and have been working on a strategy to increase awareness of the Trust in the local community. This includes a comprehensive review of advertising and publicity, and improvements to the Trust website. These improvements are now complete, and Trustees are hopeful this will result in larger uptake of applications.
	Trustees are aware of the significant decrease in the value of the investment portfolio. However the fall in value of 18.1% compares favourably with the fall in the FT100 of 27.3% in the same period.
