TRUSTEE'S REPORT

The trustee's present their reports and accounts for the year ended 31st December 2019.

Since the last report for the year ended 31st December 2018, there has not been any significant changes from the operations of the charity to update in the current report.

During the period of this report, some activities undertaken by the charity and future development plans are outlined below.

a. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN TO FURTHER THE CHARITY'S PURPOSES FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT

1. #RAISING KINGDOM ACHIEVERS

In 2019, the church started a campaign #RaisingKingdomAchievers. This is aimed at encouraging members of the church, as Christians to discover their God inspired vision, divine assignment and place of assignment. Members are challenged to run with this knowledge by faith, maximising opportunities around them to create wealth for their personal reward and benefit of their communities. In this campaign, wealth creation is achieved by working hard and smart, to develop products and services that are beneficial to others.

b. REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

During the period under review, we maintained our connection and relationship with various members of our community in many ways. c. PRINCIPAL FUNDING
