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## Independent examiner's report to the trustees of The Judd School Parents' Association

I report to the trustees on my examination of the accounts of The Judd School Parents' Association (the Association) for the year ended 31 July 2019.

# Responsibilities and basis of report

As the charity trustees of the Association you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').

I understand that you have considered clause 11 of the Association's constitution and concluded that the intention behind the requirement to elect an auditor who is not a member of the Committee to audit the accounts of the Association was to ensure that there was scrutiny of the accounts and records by somebody independent of the Committee and that it was envisaged that this would be another member of the Association. Consequently you have concluded that this requirement is met by an independent examination pursuant to section 145 of the Act. I also understand that it has been agreed that an updated constitution is to be adopted at the next general meeting of the Association. Attention is drawn to clause 12 of the existing constitution and consideration should be given as to whether prior written permission is required from the Charity Commission to adopt the updated constitution.

I report in respect of my examination of the Association's accounts carried out under section 145 of the Act and in carrying out my examination I have followed all the applicable Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the Act. The trustees should note that an independent examination is not an audit.

### Independent examiner's statement

I have completed my examination. I confirm that no material matters have come to my attention in connection with the examination giving me cause to believe that in any material respect:

1. accounting records were not kept in respect of the Association as required by section 130 of the Act; or

2. the accounts do not accord with those records.

I have no concerns and have come across no other matters in connection with the examination to which attention should be drawn in this report in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.
