Financial gift made to a local children's hospice, and other financial aid given to assist in a number of areas of need supported by other charitable organisations. Food parcels provided for the sick, elderly and needy. We have assisted in developing a local community garden. Weekly meetings held for worship, bible study and prayer, all of which are open to the local community.
