# Financial Statement for the Year ended December 31st 2018

### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements have been prepared with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 together with the applicable accounting standards and the SORP 2005.

The financial statements have been prepared under the historic cost convention except for the valuation of investment assets which are shown at market value. The statement includes all transactions, assets and liabilities for which the PCC is responsible in law. They do not include the accounts of Church groups that owe their main affiliation to another body, nor those that are informal gatherings of Church members.

## 2. FUNDS

Endowment funds are funds the capital of which must be maintained. Only income arising from the investment of the Endowment may be used, and must be treated as restricted or unrestricted according to the purpose for which the endowment was established.

Restricted funds represent the following:

- a). income from trusts or endowments which may be expanded only on those restricted objects stated in the terms of bequest.
- b). donations or grants for, or invited by, the PCC for a specific object.

The funds may also be spent on that specific object, and any amount remaining unspent at the end of the financial year must be carried forward as a balance in the particular funds concerned. The PCC maintains separate accounts for each of its restricted funds, but income form Bengeworth School share account is paid into the Education cash account, which is treated as having the same object.

Unrestricted funds are general funds which can be used for the PCC's ordinary purposes.

### 3. INCOMING RESOURCES

Planned giving, collections and donations are recognised when received. Tax refunds are recognised when the incoming resource to which they relate is received. Grants and legacies are accounted for when the PCC is legally to the amounts due.

Dividends are accounted for when receivable, and interest is recorded as of the date of the last quarterly statement before the end of the financial year. All other income is recognised when it is received. All incoming resources are accounted for gross.

### 4. RESOURCES EXPENDED

Grants and donations are accounted for when paid over, or when awarded if the award creates a binding or constructive obligation on the PCC. The diocesan parish share is paid in instalments and each payment is accounted for at the date when it is made. Amounts received specifically for mission are paid into the general fund but treated as restricted. All other expenditure is generally recognised when it is incurred and is accounted for gross.

### 5. FIXED ASSETS

In accordance with section 96(2)a of the Charities Act 1993, consecrated and benefice property is not included in the accounts. Movable church furnishings held by the Vicar and Churchwardens on special trust for the PCC and which require a faculty for disposal are inalienable property listed in the Church inventory which can be inspected at any time. For anything acquired prior to 2000 there is insufficient cost information available and therefore such assets are not valued in the financial statements.

Individual items of equipment used within the Church premises and having a purchase price of £500 or less are written off when the asset is acquired.

Investments are valued at market price at 31st December.

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### Basis of preparing the financial statements

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity when authorised by the Worcester Board of Finance.

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the receipts and payments basis except for shareholdings that are accounts for using the valuation basis.

#### Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

#### Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

#### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity when authorised by the Worcester Board of Finance.
