1. AGM arrangements 2020

Noted reasons for postponement are as follows

- Dealing with Cancer patients who are the most vulnerable people in the population with many shielding.
- The number of people who can meet together under Government rules.
- Would a meeting room be covid compliant?
- Members age profile - some don't have a mobile phone or email and social media is also a problem for them. So for us we would not be able to hold an AGM remotely.

Conclusions and actions.

Postpone the AGM - inform the membership and tell them why

Revisit our decision on a regular basis. Continue to minute our decisions.

Send in the Accounts to the Charity Commission informing them that they have not been approved at an AGM and why we postponed the AGM.

We continue to provide support and services to our members where and when we can in line with Government guidelines and our own safeguarding assessments.

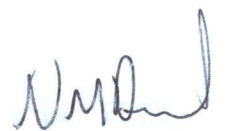

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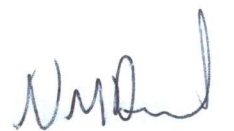
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
