

Dorridge Methodist Church Annual Report 2019-20.

Last year's Report concluded with the words "We are looking forward to what the future holds, to the arrival of our new Minister and a more stable year" Yes our new Minister, Reverend Caroline (Caz) Hague, was welcomed in September 2019 but the future has been dominated by the worldwide Coronavirus pandemic and the year after a good start was less than stable.

Until Christmas 2019 and early 2020 things were going well and then from March 2020 onwards the Church and Community Centre was closed. Thoughts turned to how we could continue as a Church and maintain contact with the members and others in the congregation. Technology came to our aid and meetings and services took place on Zoom or Facebook. DMC Connects our weekly news sheet became very important to maintain contact and thoughts turned to thinking about new methods to support people.

Our Lay pastoral Worker has been working hard to support families as have other Members who have been contacting others by telephone and via email.

It has been a source of inspiration to see how Members and others have come together to give freely of their time and expertise in many areas.

Nevertheless the Building Team continued with its work and plans for the refurbishment of the Dining Room came to fruition with work commencing in July 2020.

Plans for the reopening of the Church and Community Centre were made with Risk Assessments following Government Advice drawn up with a view to open from September 2020 onwards.

Despite the inevitable drop in income and expenditure caused by the closure of the Church we have supported many Methodist and other charities this year. Our Church Charities were SightSavers and Shine a Light.

At this stage we can only hope and pray that with God's help the pandemic will come to an end and that we can therefore look forward to better days ahead.
